Small deciduous trees typically grow to a maximum width and height of 20'.

4. *Acer palmatum* 'Osakazuki', Japanese Maple
5. *Acer palmatum* 'Bloodgood' Japanese Maple
6. *Amelanchier canadensis*, Serviceberry
7. *Aralia spinosa*, Devil's Walking Stick
8. *Cercis canadensis*, Redbud
9. *Cornus alternifolia*, Pagoda Dogwood
10. *Cornus racemosa*, Gray Dogwood
11. *Crataegus laevigata* 'Crimson Cloud', Hawthorn
12. *Magnolia stellata* 'Royal Star', Star Magnolia
13. *Malus* 'Red Jade', 'Red Jade' Crab Apple
14. *Prunus virginiana*, Chokecherry
15. *Pyrus calleryana* 'Chanticleer', Ornamental Pear
16. *Rhus glabra* 'Laciniata', Cutleaf Smooth Sumac
17. *Rhus typhina* 'Baitiger', Tiger Eyes Sumac
18. *Sorbus aucuparia*, Mountain Ash
19. *Syringa reticulata* 'Ivory Silk', Japanese Lilac
20. *Viburnum lentago*, Nannyberry

Small conifer or evergreen trees have pyramidal shapes and are slow growers.

- *Abies concolor*, Silver Fir
- *Chamaecyparis pisifera* 'Boulevard', 'Boulevard' False Cypress
- *Chamaecyparis nootkatensis* 'Glauc', Blue Nootka False Cypress
- *Picea abies* 'Cupressina', Norway Spruce
- *Picea omorika*, Serbian Spruce
- *Picea pungens* 'Moerheim', Moerheim's Blue Spruce
- *Pinus aristata*, Bristlecone Pine
- *Pinus cembra*, Swiss Stone Pine
- *Pinus flexilis* 'Vanderwolf's Pyramid'
, Vanderwolf's Limber Pine

Columnar trees are the exclamation marks in the garden.

- *Acer platanoides* 'Columnare', Columnar Norway Maple
- *Carpinus betulus* 'Franz Fontaine', 'Franz Fontaine' Pyramidal Hornbeam
- *Fagus sylvatica* 'Dawyck Gold' or 'Dawyck Purple', Columnar European Beech
- *Ginkgo biloba* 'Princeton Sentry'
- *Juniperus chinensis* 'Mountbatten', Mountbatten Juniper
- *Malus baccata* 'Columnaris', Columnar Siberian Crab Apple
- *Picea pungens* 'Fastigiata', Columnar Blue Colorado Spruce
- *Pinus strobus* 'Fastigiata', Pyramidal White Pine
- *Pinus sylvestris* 'Fastigiata', Scots Pine
- *Quercus robur* 'Fastigiata', Pyramidal English Oak
- *Taxus cuspidata* 'Clipped Cone', Pyramid Japanese Yew

Weeping trees are the smaller and more dramatic versions of the original uprights.

- *Betula pendula* 'Youngii', Young's Weeping Birch
- *Catalpa bignonioides* 'Nana', Umbrella Tree or Southern Catalpa
- *Cercidiphyllum japonicum* 'Pendula', Weeping Katsura Tree
- *Cercis canadensis* 'Covey', Redbud 'Lavender Twist'
- *Fagus sylvatica* 'Purple Fountain', Weeping Purple European Beech
- *Larix decidua* 'Pendula', Weeping European Larch
- *Malus* 'Red Jade', 'Red Jade' Weeping Crab Apple
- *Morus alba* 'Pendula', Weeping White Mulberry
- *Pinus strobus* 'Pendula', Weeping White Pine
- *Tsuga canadensis* 'Pendula', Sargent's Weeping Hemlock

Ornamental standards are very small trees that rarely exceed 6' in height.

- *Caragana arborescens* 'Walker', Walker's Weeping Siberian Peashrub
- *Cotoneaster apiculatus*, Cranberry Cotoneaster
- *Euonymus fortunei* 'Emerald Gaiety', 'Emerald Gaiety' Euonymus
- *Hydrangea paniculata* 'Kyushu', 'Kyushu' Peegee Hydrangea
- *Malus sargentii* 'Tina', Weeping Ornamental Crab Apple 'Tina'
- *Prunus triloba* 'Multiplex', Flowering Almond
- *Prunus serrulata* 'Kiku-Shidare', Weeping Japanese Cherry
- *Salix caprea* 'Pendula', Weeping Pussy Willow
- *Syringa meyeri* 'Palibin', Dwarf Korean Lilac (standard)
- *Weigela florida* 'Bristol Ruby', 'Bristol Ruby' Weigela (standard)
